closes expanded Series A funding round with over S\$5m raised**

Singapore, 6 May 2018 - CapBridge Pte Ltd (“CapBridge”), the global private capital platform supported by Singapore Exchange (“SGX”), today announced the appointment of Mr Chew Sutat as a Non-Executive Director. Mr Chew is currently Executive Vice President and Head of Equities & Fixed Income at SGX.

Investors in CapBridge include venture capitalist Tim Draper, Singapore and international family offices, and SGX.

The CapBridge platform currently has over US\$250m investable live deals from high-growth companies actively seeking growth capital.

Powered by the CapBridge investment sharing process, institutional investors actively lead funding rounds with accredited investors co-investing alongside these expert lead investors.
